
Press Kit



The DFC Kitesurf Club (composed of 217 members in 2014) organizes from the 27th July to the 02nd August 2015 in Dunkirk area, a big event in the world of water sports : the Triple King Contest. Based on its in-depth experience acquired from the organization of several world cups and French Freestyle Championship, the DFC is eager to gather all the most dynamic forces in the region, so that, this event will be recalled as a major contest in the world of Kitesurfing and in Dunkirk area. This event is set of a French Freestyle Championship associated to an European Big Air contest, and an promotional SUP (Stand Up Paddle Board) contest, in order to guarantee a thrilling show. A gliding sports village will be mounted with flagship activities such as Bungee Jumping and Bagjump.

• The French Freestyle Championship with F-ONE

The championship recently organized in 2013 is remained as one of the best ever organized at the national level. Indeed, the federal officials and the best French competitors have been really pampered, compared to the other events they use to experience during the year. This year, around forty competitors should be present. Moreover, this event was the perfect occasion for the many tourists and the people of Dunkirk to enjoy several free and extreme activities.





• European CABRINHA Big Air Contest

The "Big Air" is a slightly different Freestyle field, in the sense that it is more spectacular and accessible to the audience. Indeed, the winning criteria for this kind of event are: the height of the jumps, a more fluid style, and commitment in all conditions. This kind of event is highly sought after by the world's leading specialists in Freestyle, because they can break loose and express their talent. Freestyle is much more codified, binding and difficult to understand for the general public.

The **#TKC2013** saw the exceptional presence of **Toby BRAEUER**, the undisputed master of Aistyle. He showed, with some of the best world riders, one of the finest show in Kitesurf. And they are of course expected for this new edition in 2015 ! This should make a fifty competitors.

Promotional SUP Contest

SUP or Stand Up Paddle Board is a discipline that knows an exponential growth in the world of water sports. Many kitesurfers get the training on days without wind, to stay on top form. The local club SUP59 (with its 50 members) rides on the wave of SUP development wants to join the DFC in order to organize a promotional contest in 2015. The contest will be this weekend depending on weather conditions and will be open to all. It will count for the general classification of Triple King Contest with many prizes to win.



• Free extreme animations

In addition to the bungee jumping to 65 meters hight, the Bagjump will allow the tourists and the people of Dunkirk to experience the thrill of a 8 to 10 meter high jump. So everyone could pretend to be a stunt man! Besides this animation for the public, professionals are working since one year to provide to Dunkirk a show with jumps of 30 meters! Spectacle and thrills guaranteed!



• The village of sliding sport

These extreme animations will be set during a week, in a big sliding sports village. Thanks to the "semaine fun" organized by the city of Dunkirk, many other free activities will proposed to the public: mini paddle boat, water roller, SUP, skateboard, kayak and so on... as well as concerts, a podium bus, and animations related to the "clean event" with Urban community of Dunkirk (CUD).

About two dozen of exhibitors related to Kite Surf and SUP brands, as well as local merchants will be present. The organization wants to provide to all the Dunkirk's associations a space to promote their activities. Each association of Dunkirk could expose its activities and why not recruit new members!

• Sustainable Development Event

This event get the label "Sustainable Event" from the French Olympic and Sporting Committee (CNOSF). The social aspect of the event is put forward by the free nature of the show that provides access to the largest number. Free initiations will be proposed, and above all the public will be able to participate to all the activities of the village. At the environmental level, the event will preserve the Natura 2000 site, in which the competition will take place. Sorting wastes will be organized will the Company Clean Event. Digital communication will be promoted. The poster printing will be reduced and made with natural inks (Imprim' Vert). Finally, at the economic level, the event will mainly work with local businesses such as restaurants, printers, surf shops... the local supply is this favored.
