With its organization of several World Cups and Championships in France, the DFC club wants to bring together all the forces of the region to keep this event in the memories of the world of Kitesurf and Dunkirk. This IFKO World Championship will be an opportunity to show all the possible supports offered by kite for valid and invalid people. Supports ranging from Catakite to buggy, not to mention the Kitender thanks to the FFVL. Free introductions will be offered to all motivated people.

A village of animations, offering many free animations, will be mounted thanks to the fun week of the city of Dunkirk.

The IFKO Kitesurf Speed Crossing World Championship

The last French Kiteboard Freestyle Championship organized in 2017 with the French Sailing Federation was recognized as one of the best organized at the national level. Indeed, the federal officials and all the best French competitors have really appreciated the quality of reception, compared to other events they live during the year.

This year, the club wants the image of the Kite Challenge to turn to a test oriented to the general public. The goal is to offer the basic kite rider the opportunity to compete against the best competitors in the world.

Some sixty competitors should be present alongside the world's best, including Anais Mai DESJARDINS, Kitefoil World Champion, and licensed at the DFC.



Handikite and Catakite Demonstration

The Handikite section of the DFC will give Handikite navigation demonstrations on different media: Catakite, Kitender, buggy. This will be an opportunity for people with disabilities, but also for valid people to test these new media.



The 20 years of the club

2019 will mark the 20th anniversary of the DFC club, with its creation in 1999 on June 26, 1999. The club committee will organize a festive evening with all the actors who created, participated and contributed to the development of the club.

Sustainable event

It is not less than 2 labels that the event hopes to obtain. The first of the National Olympic and Sports Committee (CNOSF) the label "Sustainable Event". The event will allow, at the social level, access to the greatest number by the free show. Free introductions will be offered and especially the public will be able to participate in all activities of the
